**SOUTH HILLS INTERFAITH MOVEMENT FOOD PANTRIES**: During the past months, South Hills Interfaith Movement has seen its client list continue to grow. As a result, the Food Pantry is low on some staples. SHIM needs jars of spaghetti sauce, ketchup, mustard, salad dressing and boxes of cereal.

**FOOD PACKAGING EVENT:** On Sunday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, Mission & Outreach is hosting a food packaging event. Rise Against Hunger is the new name for Stop Hunger Now who partnered with us two years ago for a food event in our Auditorium. On March 4<sup>th</sup>, we will pack 11,106 meals. We will need 50 volunteers to pack food and 10 volunteers to set up and clean up after the event. It is the host's responsibility to not only provide the volunteers, but also fund the event, so if you feel led to sponsor some meals, check out the bulletin board by the chairlift to track our progress and learn more about Rise Against Hunger. We are "Changed by Christ So We Can Change the World" and this is an excellent opportunity to live out that mission.

**2018 PER CAPITA:** The per capita amount for 2018 is \$33.05 and is set by the Pittsburgh Presbytery to support operations of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly. This amount is per active member, not per family.
