(In order to supplement food donations, SHIM makes up to six monthly visits to the Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank. During each visit, SHIM purchases roughly 3,000 pounds of food to supply the needs of its patrons.) SHIM will soon be starting its Community Gardens, a project that supplies fresh produce to all of the Food Pantries. Additional funds are necessary to get this project underway. The money we collect during Fellowship helps many of our neighbors living in the South Hills.
