NATURE AND SCOPE OF POSITION

The Worship Leader shall equip and encourage the congregation in working to fulfill the vision of Bethel Presbyterian Church: *to be a Christ-centered community of hope, truth, encouragement, and peace in this uncertain time when people are searching for something and Someone to hold onto*. They will, especially, be charged with lifting up the congregation's value statement regarding worship: "We believe that it is in our worship that God's people primarily give glory to God. We gather to honor and praise our Lord, to learn the Truth of God's Word, and to be strengthened for daily living. We strive for our worship services to be joyful and warm, and to include the variety of voices and styles that invite all into the genuine worship of our Lord."

General Duties and Responsibilities

The Worship Leader will be charged with encouraging and leading the congregation in its worship, primarily in the contemporary worship service, but also in combined/blended services and special services throughout the year.

Depending on the passions, skills, and availability of the worship leader, duties may be expanded to include teaching contemporary worship in the children's music program and/or in providing off-site worship in alternate settings.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

- Work with the Pastor and REVIVE Ministry Team to plan and lead meaningful contemporary worship that inspires worship and deepened discipleship.
- Work with the music leadership team to plan and lead meaningful blended worship for periodic combined and special services.
- Gather and coordinate a small ensemble of musicians from the congregation or community to provide for musical worship performance and to undergird congregational singing.
- Coordinate and communicate with all graphics and sound volunteer teams to ensure a smooth flow of worship.
- Research and recommend new and improved technologies related to sound, video, streaming, and graphics.
- Keep informed of copyright and licensing laws and seek compliance with them in the use of all materials.
- Fulfill other appropriate duties and responsibilities as may be determined by the Pastor

Accountability

The Worship Leader shall work under the administrative direction and supervision of the Pastor as Head of Staff.

Supervisory Responsibilities

There are currently no direct reports to this position, but they will be responsible for working with several teams of volunteers.

Position Requirements

- **General**
 - Demonstrated personal relationship with Jesus Christ through worship, prayer, service and mission, knowledge of Scripture and church doctrine, and a desire to work in a ministry setting.
 - Strong time-management and project management skills.
 - Ability and desire to work as a member of a team, communicating and coordinating with staff and volunteers to reach a common goal.
 - Willingness and attention to planning for worship a week or more ahead for musicians that need more practice.
 - Act 33/34 clearances are required.
- **Worship and Technology**
 - Appreciation of the fullness and breadth of musical styles that belong to the worship voice of people around the world and through the ages.
 - In-depth knowledge of a variety of contemporary worship music and a willingness and ability to plan for occasional worship that incorporates both traditional and contemporary music.
 - Musical proficiency and talent: vocal and solo instrument (guitar / piano/ etc.)
 - Knowledge of worship technologies, including sound, video, streaming, and graphics.
 - Ability to recruit, coordinate, and lead volunteer musicians of all ages and of varying experience levels, encouraging them to share their gifts and passions in glorifying God and for the building up of the church.
