

OUR TERRIFIC THREES

This is a busy month for our threes! We will begin the month by talking about Groundhog's day and have fun exploring shadows. We will also talk about dental health and healthy foods and then end the month celebrating the world of Dr. Seuss!

We look forward to a special visitor this month.... a dental hygienist who will visit our classes on Feb. 26th to teach us about dental hygiene! In our preschool class we'll also talk about caring and sharing at school and at home as we get ready for our Valentine's Day Party on Feb. 14th. The children are to bring in <u>signed but not addressed Valentines</u> for the children in their class (15 students in Mrs. Shaw's AM class, 14 students in Mrs. Dawson's AM class & 11 students in Mrs. Shaw's PM class). We ask for the envelopes to be blank so that the children can "mail" their own Valentines to their friends!

We will continue our study of colors by having Orange Day on Feb. 7th, Pink Day on Feb. 12th, Yellow Day on Feb. 21st and Purple Day on Feb. 26th. We will ask the children to dress in the color of the day and will do activities with the color of the day theme. A hair ribbon or pin or socks with those colors will do just fine if your child doesn't have clothes for the color of the day!

OUR FABULOUS 3-DAY FOURS

We are planning many activities for this month. We will learn about letters Gg, Ss, Jj, Dd, Pp & Bb and the numbers 6, 7 and 8. We will talk about Groundhog's day as we have fun playing with shadows in science class. We will also experiment in science with the concepts of sink and float. Our Valentine's Day Party will be on Wednesday,

February 13th. Please send in <u>signed but not addressed</u> Valentines for each member of your child's class (16 students in Mrs. P's AM class, 14 students in Mrs. Sargent's AM class and 16 students in Mrs. Sargent's PM class). We like them to be able to "mail" their Valentines to their friends, so please leave the envelopes blank.

Another highlight this month will be learning about Presidents, particularly George Washington and Abraham Lincoln as we learn facts about each of them. Students will also start to learn their home addresses; we appreciate your help with practicing at home! The teachers will also continue to evaluate students this month for Kindergarten readiness in preparation for parent/teacher conferences on February 25th. If you haven't already signed up for a time slot for your conference, please reach out to your child's teacher. There will be **no classes** for students on conference day.

SIX GOOD REASONS TO HAVE YOUR CHILD SCREENED FOR SPEECH-LANGUAGE-HEARING SKILLS

- Early identification of communication problems prevents complications arising from undetected speech, language or hearing needs.
- Speech-language impairments may affect social/emotional development.
- Early identification and treatment of speech and language problems can promote reading development and school success.
- 4) Standardized screening provides information about areas not addressed at well-child visits
- 5) Great opportunity to prepare children for similar educational screening experiences.
- 6) Services are provided by American Speech-Language-Hearing Association Certified and PA State Licensed Speech-Language Pathologists.




